- Required by state law to be updated every 5 years in order to receive certain funding.

TOWN CENTER LIVABLE CENTERS INITIATIVE (LCI)

- The purpose of the Atlanta Regional Commission’s LCI Program is to create vibrant, walkable communities.
- The Town Center LCI Plan originally developed in 2001 and last updated in 2012.
- This update focuses on mobility improvements to support a range of travel modes.

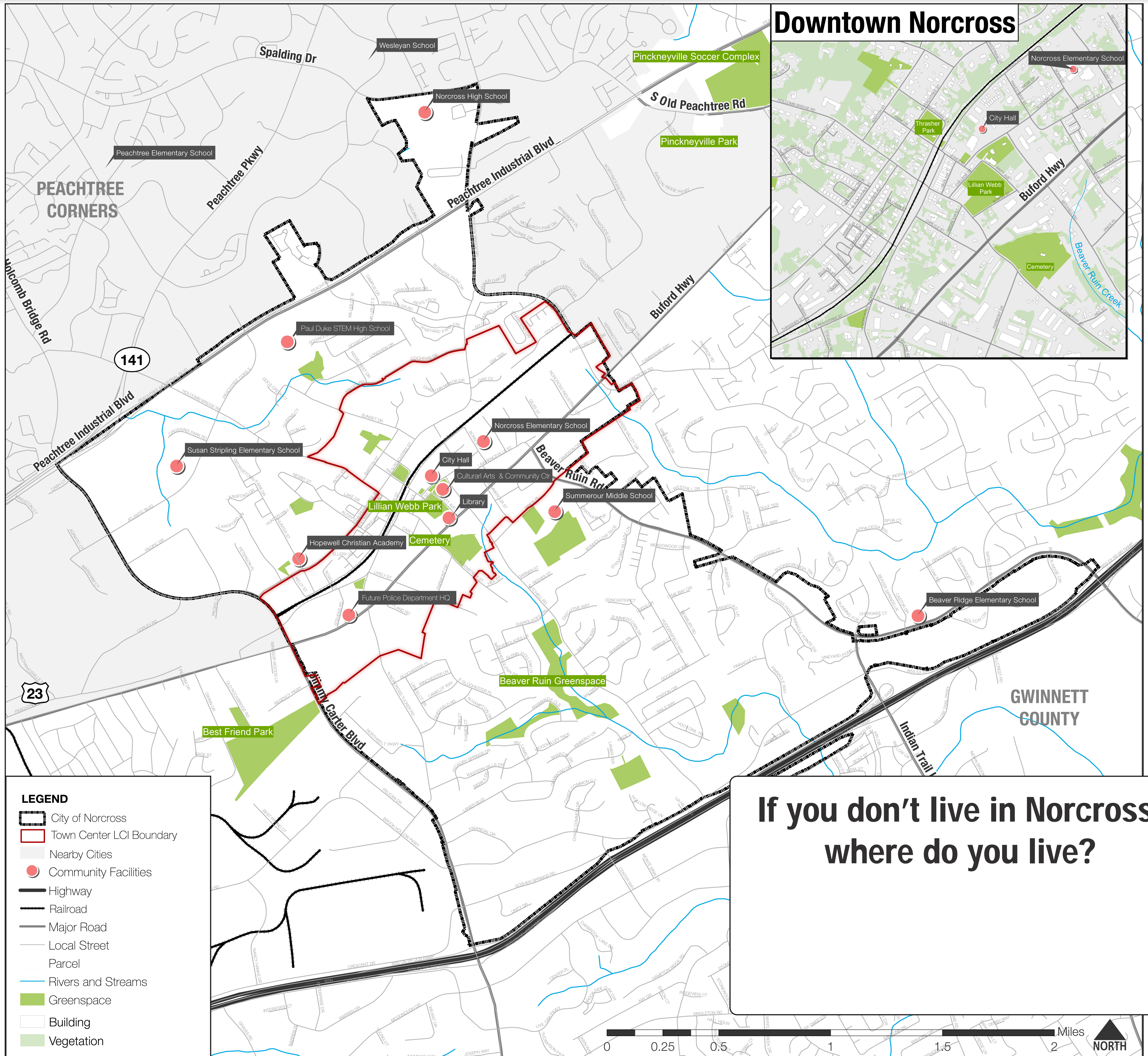

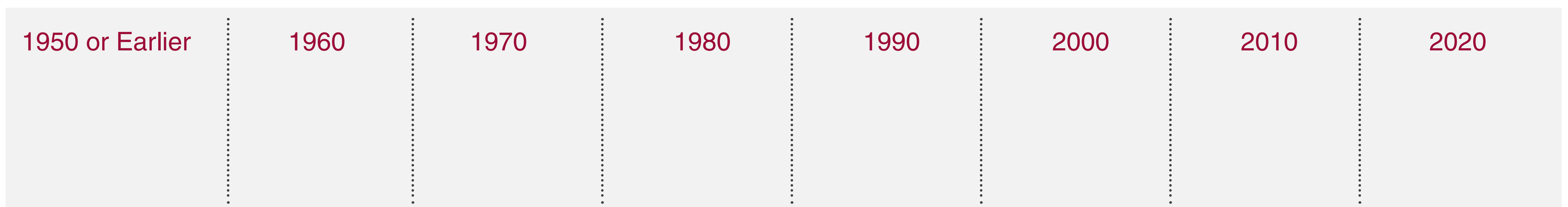

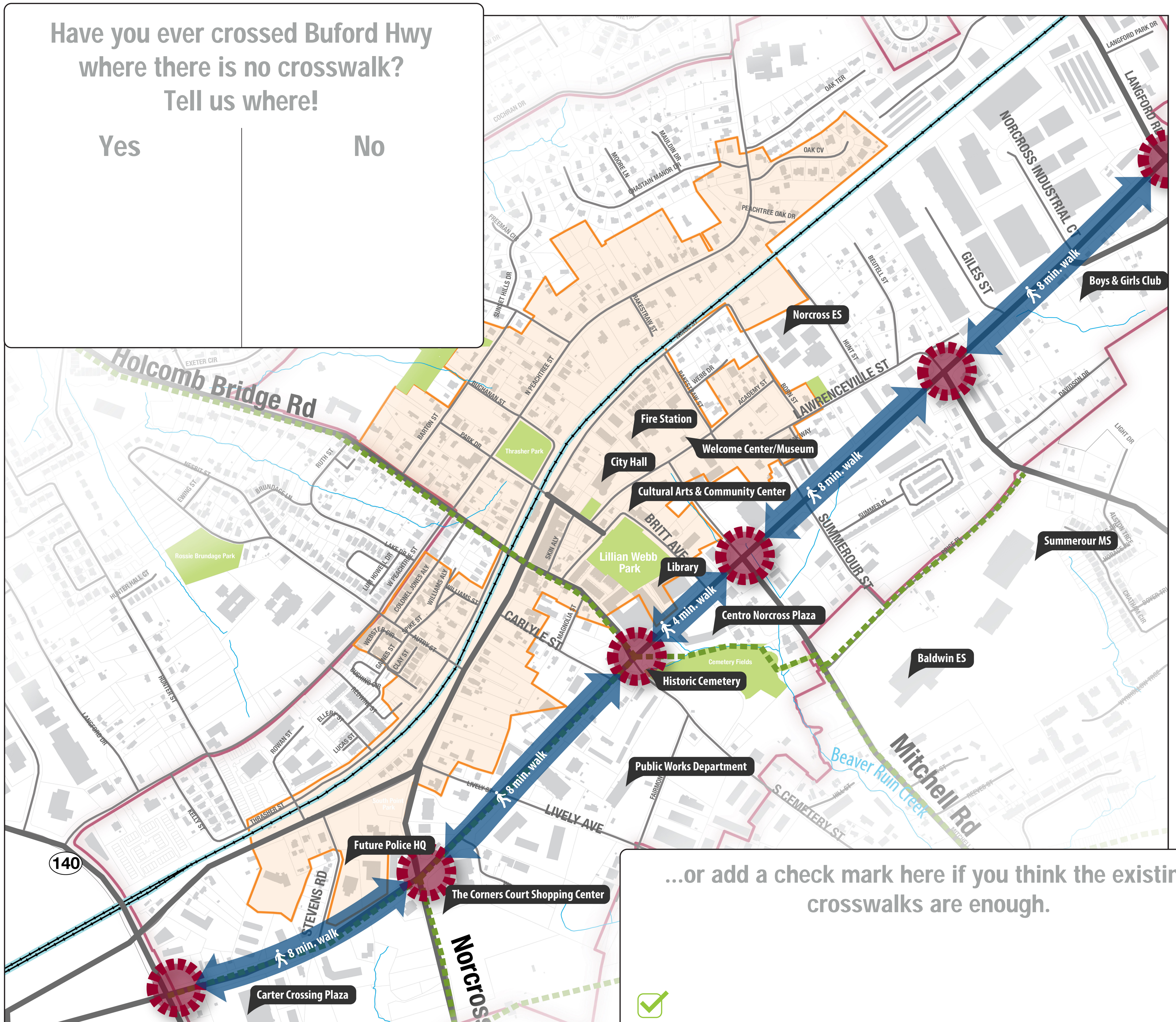
How can we make the Town Center more walkable?
